Do not peel a film off the cartridge.



6 Close the ink cartridge cover, the output paper support and the scanner cover. When the DCP is setup for the first time, the machine will prepare the Brother unique ink tube system for use for the first time. This process will occur only once, the first time ink cartridges are installed. The preparation process will last up to four minutes.

 DO NOT remove ink cartridges if you do not need to replace them.
 If you do so, it may reduce the ink quantity and the DCP will not know the quantity of ink left in the cartridge.

 If ink stains your body or clothing, wash with soap or detergent immediately.
